## CALL FOR PILOT PROPOSALS

\$35,000 AWARDED FOR 1-YEAR OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE RESEARCH

## **DESCRIPTION OF PILOT:**

CIRAD is accepting applications for its pilot project program. Projects may include primary data collection and/or secondary data analysis, and may leverage ADRD-related projects taking place at Columbia University Irving Medical Center or in New York City. <u>A budget of up to \$50,000 for</u> <u>applicants from Columbia University is possible.</u>

Projects should focus on aspects of human research in ADRD,

including diagnosis, biomarkers, risk and resilience factors, interventions and caregiving. Basic science projects may be considered if they have a translational potential in ADRD disparities.

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY:**

- Postdoctoral scientists/fellows, early or mid-career faculty.
- Must meet the <u>NIH definition of underrepresented in</u> <u>biomedical research.</u>
- Must be interested in <u>Alzheimer's Disease and related</u> dementias (ADRD) research.
